V. Board Committee Reports

a. Building Committee –Mr. Stephen Morris stated the meeting was held on June 2, 2015 to discuss summer work. The main topic was lawn mowers. The current situation on the mowers is the Grade School mower is 17 years old and the other is not big enough to mow all of the property. The Woods mower needs service at the Jr/Sr High School. Mr. Morris stated the committee even discussed the possibility of trading all of the mowers for a larger mower/tractor. The final decision was to hold off until we see what the financial situation is going to be with the funding. The committee thought maybe a zero turn mower may be needed and would share between the buildings and keep only the tractor to move snow. The summer work is basically cleaning and there are some doors on the life safety survey. The main door causing a lot of issues in this building is the door by the concession and boy's bathroom. That door doesn't seem to shut or latch. The recommendation is to make that an emergency only exit. An alarm device would need to be purchased that way at ballgames if someone opens the door we would know if they are letting people inside. It will have an off and on feature for them to be able to bring in supplies for the concession stand.

- VIII. Principals' Report—Submitted in Board packet, currently attending a conference.
 - IX. Superintendent's Report –Dr. Jennifer Garrison stated the first thing to talk about is the Community Eligibility Provision for the Jr/Sr High School. It's the program that offers free lunch and breakfast to all students. We have had this at the Grade School now for 3 years and this will be our 4th year. It's based on direct certification only. 37 out of 68 Jr High students who were direct certified and 85 out of 149 at the High School. When looking at our reimbursement rate we would get 87% of our lunches based on a meal count reimbursed at the Federal rate and then the rest of the lunches at the paid rate. Jr High 87% free rate at \$3.06 and the other 13% will be .36 cents. For the High School 91%. The board members present stated to go forward with submitting the paperwork.

Dr. Garrison reported the State owes \$20,462 in Pre-K money and \$350.76 for a total of \$20,812.76. Mrs. Gore had suggested to look into Lorenz Supply Co for our Custodian bulk order. By going with them the school will save \$2833.08. The order will be placed with Lorenz Supply.

Dr. Garrison met with Kevin Wills from First Mid State on our 2005-2008 Bonds. We're entering the time where we can refinance our bonds. We are probably looking at \$10-15,000 dollars savings for the remaining life of the bonds. If we refinance that is still \$10-15,000 dollars of the tax payer's money we would not

need to collect over the next 15 years. Dr. Garrison is recommending to have a finance committee meeting within the next month or two. Kevin will come to do a presentation to the committee. Then the Board can decide to move forward or not. The finance committee is Heather Day, Darin Brandt and Jered Gambill.
