- a. Policy/Handbook Committee---Dr. Garrison stated the committee has held two meetings on June 7th and June 14th. The committee has accomplished an agreement for Jr/Sr High and Grade school dress code and cell phone language. Information has been provided for members to look over the changes.

Mr. Morris stated he would like to have added in the Policy book a return check policy ---after the 3rd return check no longer allowed to accept checks. He also thanked the committee for their hard work. Next policy committee meeting will be held July 28 from 6:00 p.m. to 8:30 p.m.

- VIII. School Improvement Team Grant Administrators' Report---Mr. Dannaman stated the report is in their packets. He said this month is really heavy with professional development for staff members over the last few weeks. The summer program has partnered with Shalom. They have provided lunch and for the next three weeks in July we will be using their building for classes. The School Improvement staff have been great help. Roughly 25-30 students have been attending each day.
- IX. Principals' Report---Mrs. Benjamin stated her report is in their packets. She would like to recognize Levi Brown and Brandon Phipps both will be attending the State FFA Convention and each will be receiving awards. Mrs. Benjamin wanted to thank the board for working on the handbook, thanked the Shalom in helping out and providing lunch at the Church. The Methodist Church is allowing us to use the building during the month of July.

Mrs. Gray stated her report is also in their packet. She also wanted to recognize Kade Gambill who will be receiving the highest award a FFA member can receive, The American FFA Degree. She also thanked Mr. Buddy for his hard work in getting the grade school ready for the students and teachers.

- X. Superintendent's Report---Dr. Garrison stated the State currently owes us a grand total of \$289,470.56. The school funding reform bill did pass both house and senate, now waiting on Governor's signature. Governor has said he will veto it. June 30th will be the next meeting at Springfield.
- a. EPA soil sampling---Dr. Garrison stated we do not have all the EPA soil sampling back. July 11th is when we should have the validated results. Michael Berkoff is the Remedial Project Manager and has been working with the Dr. Garrison and the Sandoval Village Board about the WJBD post and how it has caused alarm in the community. Mr. Berkoff didn't realize how this has affected the community. They are currently working together on a plan how to communicate this information better to the community. We were 3 of the 12 sites tested here in Sandoval. The Mayor of Sandoval and Dr. Garrison suggesting possibly a joint meeting to go over and discuss the results.


