VIII. School Improvement Team Grant Administrators' Report---Mr. Jett stated the report was included in their board packet. Mr. Jett stated they had career night with 6 alumni to come and talk about the good, the bad, and the ugly of their careers. We did not have the numbers we were hoping for that evening. There were 23 in attendance on Friday night. Some of the feedback they received from the alumni was they were impressed with the questions the students asked. A lot of the kids were 8<sup>th</sup> graders and asked questions that some would think that 8<sup>th</sup> graders wouldn't be thinking of. After speaking with Mr. Danamann we are hoping to try to offer this during the day maybe in the first semester and then offer 1 in the evening. The following Alumni were here speaking to the students.

Ryan Quick "Class of 2009"

Mechanical Engineer at North American Lighting. Ryan talked about the math and science components of his job. He talked about his experience in the pre-engineering program at KC and how well it transferred to SIU-E.

Jered Gambill "Class of 2002"

Occupational Therapist at KSED. Jered talked about the college requirements for his job and the financial rewards of the Occupational Therapy Assistant program that KC offers.

Kelly Dahl "Class of 2008"

Pharmacist at Bandy's in Salem. Kelly talked about the amount of debt she built up due to college loans. She stressed the importance of her academic scholarships which helped to lessen her debt and is allowing her to build a home in Sandoval.

Officer Steve Korzenewski "Class of 1991"

- IX. Principals' Report---Mrs. Benjamin reported her report is in the board packet. Mrs. Benjamin stated she would like to recognize and thank Mr. Jett and Mr. Danamann for all their hard work and getting the Community involved. Also thanked Mr. Jered Gambill for participating in career night. Mrs. Benjamin said she wanted to update the board on Science. She stated we have a math teacher that will be teaching more science since the numbers were low. The teacher is also licensed to teach Math and Science. Mrs. Strole has been working with KC in regards to having Jordan Coffey to come and speak to the Junior and Seniors about the Math and Science classes being offered at KC. This would be giving the students the opportunity to complete some college level classes. Mrs. Benjamin stated in the Tech meeting they have had the discussion about looking into or having the availability to offer the students the on-line service for Spanish. Mrs. Benjamin said she would like to thank LeeAnn Speiser for stepping up and taking over the Prom as well as thanking Mrs. Towell for taking over and doing the fundraiser part needed for the Prom.

There was some miscommunication through WJBD on Emily's election. It was reported from Steven Fox to Bruce from WJBD that she needed 50 votes and that was incorrect, verified through the Illinois State Board of Elections and confirmed will be getting her certificate along with Theresa. Currently the State owes \$ 229,694.99 Expenditures to date Education Fund 86%, Building Fund 59.30 % and Transportation 63.84%.

XI. Old Business

a. Update on Security System Quotes ---Josh from Security Alarm met last Friday about lock sensors for all of the doors. What was actually recommended is panic buttons. We need to consider where we would want to place them and then it sends out immediately to the fire and the police departments when the button is pushed. Dr. Garrison stated she would reach out to Josh from Security Alarm to see if the fire and police system we are currently using could be linked together without an additional monthly cost.

b. AdvancED Accreditation Visit ---Dr. Garrison stated she wanted to celebrate together and thank Mr. Hanks and Mr. Morris for answering all of their questions. The AdvancED team interviewed the students, staff and some parents. The feedback at the end was very emotional and overall results were as a District we have 2 years of growth in 1 year.
