Active Shooter – Due to an increase in the number of school shootings, we have taken steps to be prepared for a school attack. Drills and printed materials has been developed to cover strategies and tips for surviving an intruder’s attack.

(Active Shooter Drill/Lockout)

Fire Drills – Per state law and educational guidelines, Sandoval conducts periodically practice fire drills at the Junior/Senior High and the Elementary schools. These drills occur once each semester. They are aimed at instructing students and staff of what to do to safely vacate the buildings in case of a fire and where to meet to be account for each student.

Natural Events – Plans are created to cover weather-related events, like snow and ice storms, as well as events than may spring up unexpectedly like tornados, electrical storms, etc.

District-wide Safety Measures

1. Surveillance System – A video monitoring system is installed at the Junior/senior high school and at the Elementary school to monitor the entry doors, hallways and school public areas.
2. Entry door access – Entry doors are locked to the outside and have a monitoring system. Outside guests and visitors must request and be granted access in order to enter the buildings. Guests are also requested to sign-in at the main office and indicated the nature of their business.
